Shelby Energy Cooperative will award an all-expense paid educational trip for three high school juniors to Washington, D.C. During this weeklong trip, students will learn about our nation's history and its government, rural electrification, and will make new friends from across the nation.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Be a high school junior.
- Follow all contest rules.
- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must be a member in good standing with Shelby Energy Cooperative. (Excludes immediate family of employees and directors of Shelby Energy Cooperative.)

CONTEST RULES:

- Complete the entry form and submit it with a current school photograph **(head & shoulders pose only)**.
- Submit an essay of at least 500 words, typed and double-spaced. Essays will be judged on content, grammar and spelling. Topic for essay: **"Please tell us something special that you have accomplished or experienced in your life that we haven't seen in another part of your application."**
- A recommendation letter written by the student's high school guidance counselor or English teacher.
- List of high school activities and work history.
- Finalists are asked to attend Shelby Energy's Annual Meeting in June where they will be introduced to the membership.
- All applications and essays must be submitted to a Shelby Energy office by **Friday, March 9, 2018 by 4:30 p.m.**
- Semi-finalists will be selected to attend the Frankfort VIP tour in March.
- Finalists selected for the Washington, D.C. Youth Tour will be notified following the Frankfort Youth Tour.

Selection Process

Students will only be judged by employees of Shelby Energy Cooperative in the Frankfort VIP Tour category. All other categories will be judged by non-employees. These judges will select semi-finalists to attend the Frankfort Youth Tour and finalists for the Washington, D.C. Youth Tour.

Judging Criteria:

1. **Essay** – 60 points (Content, grammar, and spelling)
2. **Letter of recommendation** – 10 points
3. **School activities and work history** – 10 points
4. **Frankfort tour participation** – 20 points
